## Delegations

♦ Wilfrid Worland of the Qualicum Refugee Sponsorship Group provided an update on the progress of settling another refugee family in the Oceanside community.

## Council Business

♦ Request to send a letter to the Provincial Government in support of protection of areas 74A, 76B and 82A of the CDF Moist Maritime (mm) biogeoclimatic (BEC) subzone was referred to the Town's colleagues of the Qualicum First Nation Band for consideration and comment.

♦ Request to recognize the First Nations at the opening of all Town Council meetings and Committee of the Whole meetings was referred to staff for comment and recommendations.

♦ Council appointed Councillor Avis as Trustee and Councillor Luchtmeijer as Alternate to the Vancouver Island Regional Library Board for the 2018 year.

♦ Council authorized staff to issue a Development Permit to authorize the painting of a mural on the south side of the Community Hall, as requested in the November 12, 2017 request from the Qualicum and District Curling Club, subject to further review of the exact size, location and colour.

♦ Council instructed staff to notify the Regional District of Nanaimo that Council supports the funding to In Film through Grants In Aid through the alternate requisition methods on a region wide basis.

♦ Council granted permission to the Seaside Cruizers to hold their annual Father's Day Show 'n Shine on the streets in the downtown core on Sunday, June 17, 2018 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm with full street closures as in prior years with the addition of provision for recycling stations to be set up for the event.

♦ Council granted permission to the Seaside Cruizers to hold the annual Father's Day Show 'n Shine Street Dance on Second Avenue West between Primrose Street and the lane east of the Credit Union before Memorial Avenue, on Saturday, June 16, 2018 from 5:00 pm to 10:00 pm.

♦ Council directed staff to allocate matching funding to support the completion of the Faye Smith Memorial and Brant Viewing Area improvements, as proposed by Qualicum Beach Streamkeepers and detailed in the December 11, 2017 Planning memo to Council, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

## Bylaws and Policies

♦ Council approved an amendment to Town of Qualicum Beach Policy 3010-6, Town Pins.

♦ Council authorized staff to issue Development Permit No. 1321 for 329 Hall Road, as attached to the December 11, 2017 Planning memo to Council.

♦ The bylaw entitled "Town of Qualicum Beach Land Use and Subdivision Bylaw No. 580, 1999 Amendment (210 First Avenue West) Bylaw No. 580.84, 2017" was given second reading. A public hearing regarding this bylaw will be held on Monday, January 8, 2018 at 7:00 pm at the Qualicum Beach Town Hall, 660 Primrose Street, Qualicum Beach.
