## Council Business

- ♦ The following motions were released from the February 10, 2020 closed meeting of Council:
  - THAT Council appoints Tom Whitfield representing the Brown Property Preservation Society, to the Heritage Forest Commission, for a term ending December 31, 2021;  
AND FURTHER THAT Council re-appoints to the Select Committee on Public Safety the following members: Carol Dowe, representing the Qualicum Woods Residents' Association; Ken Sherburne, representing the Oceanside Community Safety Volunteers; Bill Duckenfield, representing the Chartwell Residents Association, Liz Rotinsky as the alternate to the Chartwell Residents Association, Len Hooper, representing the D. 69 Emergency Communication Group;  
AND FURTHER THAT, Barry Bleay be appointed as the new member representing Eaglecrest Residents' Association for a two-year term ending December 31, 2021;  
AND FURTHER THAT Council adopt the amended Terms of Reference by reducing the Committee composition from 14 members to 11 members.
  - THAT Council directs staff to notify Qualicum-Parksville Kiwanis Housing Society that they are the successful proponent for the Railway Street Affordable Housing project
  - THAT all the other proponents for the Railway Street Affordable Housing project be sent a letter of appreciation for their submission
- ♦ An update on the Strategic Plan was presented, and Council reviewed the resolutions of Council meetings from 2019 and 2020.

- ♦ Council will host a future Council meeting at Kwalikum Senior Secondary School; date to be determined.
- ♦ Council will consider issuance of a Development Variance Permit for **333 Judges Row** at the Council Meeting on April 1, 2020.
- ♦ Council will consider issuance of a Development Permit and a Development Variance Permit for **217 Higson Crescent** at the Council Meeting on April 1, 2020.
- ♦ The **Age-Friendly Transportation Plan** was accepted. The Age-Friendly Transportation Plan will be forwarded to the Public Safety Committee for their review and comment.

## Bylaws

- ♦ The Town of Qualicum Beach **Financial Plan (2020-2024) Bylaw No. 738, 2019** was adopted.
- ♦ Town of Qualicum Beach Land Use and Subdivision Bylaw No. 580, 1999 Amendment (**595 Spruce Street**) Bylaw No. 580.113, 2019 was given third reading as amended. The applicant must pay a **\$5,000 landscaping charge** to cover the costs of replacing all trees removed from the subject property in a different location prior to adoption of this bylaw.
- ♦ Town of Qualicum Beach Land Use and Subdivision Bylaw No. 580, 1999 Amendment (**191 Fourth Avenue W**) Bylaw No. 580.115, 2019 was given third reading.
- ♦ Town of Qualicum Beach Land Use and Subdivision Bylaw No. 580, 1999 Amendment (**Part of Village Way and Railway Street**) Bylaw No. 580.117, 2020 (affordable housing development) was given third reading and adopted.
